Have you been through a mental health crisis? If you're aged 18-25, your experiences can help Porchlight and the NHS to improve mental health support for young people in Kent and Medway.

We'd be interested to hear from you if you have:

- Visited A&E for mental health support
- Engaged with the community mental health or crisis home treatment teams
- Had a hospital stay for intensive support
- Visited a Safe Haven or used a crisis support line (like SHOUT or Samaritans)
- Struggled to access any help at all while going through a crisis.

There are lots of ways to get involved. You can share your experiences in a one-to-one feedback session, at one of our activity days, or in one of our focus groups. We know it can be hard to talk about what you've been through. We won't pressure you to talk about anything that makes you uncomfortable, and all our discussions are confidential.

We can also help you find support for mental health issues you are currently facing.
